



Case Management

 "Case managers serve the University and individual students by arranging, coordinating, monitoring, evaluating, and advocating for students who are identified and in need of assistance."

Case Management

- Two Types in Student Affairs
 - Behavioral Intervention / Crisis
 - Student Success Support
- ECU Connect (formerly Starfish)
 - More complete student picture for case manager
- Case Managers
 - Assess student needs
 - Create connections / coordinate services
 - Generate / Support action plans
 - Empower to become self-advocacy




First Year Cares

- Survey completed during orientation (4th year)
 - Self-identify as first generation, military, disabilities, as well as their current levels of anxiety, stress, loneliness and mental health
- Align our resources in Student Affairs, as well as Academic Affairs, to begin outreach
- UNC System Grant for 2023-24 for case managers (one-year temporary funding)




Disability Support Services: Creating Access to Support Student Success Complexity / Severity Trends




